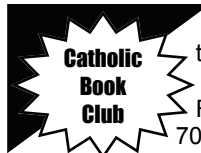
Help is needed to setup and cleanup for Bi-lingual Mass on Sundays from 12:30—2:30PM.

The **Combined Mission Collection** will be taken at all Masses the week-end of May 17-18. Your contribution

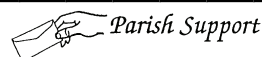
