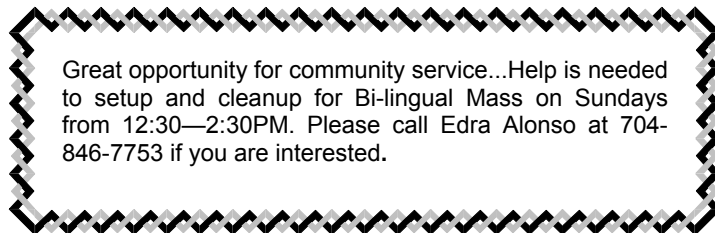

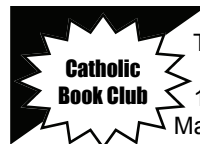

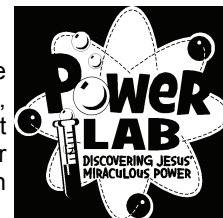
LAY MINISTRY TRAINING PROGRAM
